Check out what's happening...

This week our focus will be comparing the past and present. We will be comparing how people lived in the past to how we live today. We will also be using pictures from when we were little to compare and contrast what we could do in the past to what we can do in the present. Content Updates...

Reading: This week we will be reading Turkey Trouble and Pete the Cat and the First Thanksgiving. We will use these stories to practice sequencing and to identify examples of realism and fantasy.

Math: In math we will continue to work on showing different ways to make numbers 0-10 with manipulatives. We will also be using manipulatives to solve story problems.

Sight words/ Phonics: In phonics we will continue to work with the letter i. At this point your child should be able to read and write three letter words that contain the vowels a and i.

Social Studies: This week in social studies we will be talking about the First Thanksgiving. We will also be comparing and contrasting the past to the present.
