Check out what's happening...

As we eased back into the school routine we have been working on perfecting our sentences. We are using a four smiley face rubric to check our work. Students receive a smiley face for beginning a sentence with a capital letter, using finger spaces, an end mark, and writing a sentence that makes sense. They check their work first with the smiley faces and then I check it. This gives students a visual and also begins to get them into the habit of checking their own work! So now you will know what all those smiley faces are for on your child's writing paper!

Content Updates...

Reading: This week we will be focusing on Diversity and will be using the stories <u>We're</u> <u>Different, We're the Same</u> and <u>The Crayon</u> <u>Box That Talked</u>, to use a Venn Diagram to identify how we are like our classmates and how we are different from our classmates

Math: This week in math we will be identifying and practicing strategies we can use to solve subtraction problems.

Phonics/Sight words: This week we will be reviewing the vowels o,a, and i. Students will practice reading and writing three letter words that contain these letters.

Social Studies: We will conclude our unit on maps and globes by creating a paper
