Monday is Dr. Seuss's birthday. We will celebrate by reading lots of Dr. Seuss's stories and responding to the stories with writing. Since many of his stories contain many rhyming words we will use these stories to practice rhyming words. We will practice writing rhyming words on our desks with shaving cream. Hopefully we will even have time to squeeze in a fun art project.

Reading: This week we will continue our fairy tale unit by reading different versions of the Three Billy Goats Gruff. We will work on using a Venn diagram to compare and contrast the stories and characters.

Math: This week in math we will be working on teen numbers and representing numbers on a Tens Frame. If your child does not know all of their teen numbers be sure to practice these at home.

Phonics/Sight words: The words "here" "from" "go" and "play" will be added to our growing list of sight words. We will also work on the letter e and will work on identifying the middle sound in words.

April 13th will now be a school day due to weather closures.

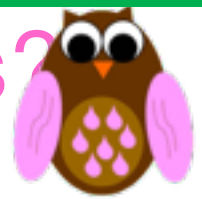
